Immunogen	Horse IgG		
Purification	The antibody was isolated from antisera by immunoaffinity chromatography using antigens coupled to agarose beads.		
Specificity	By immunoelectrophoresis and ELISA this antibody reacts specifically with Horse IgG. No antibody was detected against non immunoglobulin serum proteins.

Form	1 mg/ml. Liquid in 0.01M Phosphate Buffered Saline, pH 7.2, containing 1% BSA, 50% glycerol, 0.02% Sodium Azide		
Dilution	IH (1/100 - 1/1000), IF (1/100 - 1/1000), FC (1/1000 - 1/4000), E (Use at an assay dependent concentration)		
Fluorophore	Ex/Em = 595/615 nm		
Storage/Stability	Shipped at 4°C. Upon delivery aliquot and store at -20°C for one year. Avoid freeze/thaw cycles.
